

## Privacy Policy

Your privacy is very important to us. We, at Timbre Media Private Limited are committed to respecting your privacy online.

We recognize your need for proper protection and management of any personally identifiable information that you share with us or that we collect. Timbre Media will protect your Personal Information received from any country or jurisdiction with varying laws on protection of personal information. "Personal Information" is information or data that identifies an individual by his name, contact details such as phone, email, country, date of birth and other relevant information.

By using this web site and providing your Personal Information, you consent to the terms of our online privacy policy and to our processing of such Personal Information for the purposes explained in this policy. By registering on the site or by subscribing to a service and providing your contact details (telephone, email), you agree that this action constitutes a consent, for the purposes of the telemarketing laws, to receive information about products and services from Timbre Media. ### INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND THAT YOU PROVIDE:

Timbre Media collects information that is either anonymous or personally identifiable. We use this information to gauge the effectiveness of our site, track information for statistical purposes and to improve the products and services we provide. We use the standard "cookie" feature of major browser applications and other data capture mechanisms that allow us to store data about your visit to our website. We store information that we collect through cookies, log files and other tracking technology. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record-keeping purposes. We use session ID cookies and persistent cookies. We use session cookies to make it easier for you to navigate our site. A session ID cookie expires when you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive for an extended period of time. You can remove persistent cookies by following directions provided in your Internet browser's "help" file. Persistent cookies are used to differentiate users of the site from subscribers, to customize the content of certain sections of the site and to enable us to track and cater to the interests of users, in order to enhance their experience on the site. Cookies help us learn which areas of our site are useful and which areas need improvement. We will not use cookies or other data capture mechanisms to collect any personally identifiable information about you. You may configure your browser to prevent cookies from being set on your computer. If you reject cookies, you may still use the site, but your ability to use some areas of the site may be limited and you may not be able to use certain features of the site

We don't knowingly collect, maintain or sell products or services to people under age 18 or use personal information from our website about children under age 18.
